

WASH OFFICER, CHIOS

Role and Responsibilities:

We are looking for a WASH Officer to oversee water and environmental health at transit sites on Chios. Responsibilities include:

- Manage site cleaning services team and direct and prioritize cleaning and maintenance tasks, both internal and external based on needs and situation
- Supervise cleaning and maintenance contractor to ensure good quality services
- Work with logistics team to ensure provision of adequate hygiene and cleaning supplies
- Liaise with Municipality site managers and engineers and UNHCR representatives over WASH provision at the site
- Ensure appropriate signage and health and hygiene messaging in sites
- Prepare and track budgets for WASH activities
- Undertake and supervise any further developments of WASH infrastructure at new sites as needed
- Report on WASH activities to Samaritan's Purse and UNHCR as required

Essential criteria:

- Minimum 3 years experience in Public or Environmental Health/Water & Wastewater Engineering/Plumbing/Construction
- Experience of leading a team and managing contractors
- Languages: Excellent written and spoken Greek and English
- IT skills: confident user of Word, Excel, Outlook
- Able to cooperate and work in a dynamic and changing team environment
- Must have a high level of integrity and able to be flexible and adaptable
- Able to care for and monitor needs of refugees and vulnerable persons
- Must be able to commute to work site in Chios town area
- Must have a registered IKA/AMKA number in Greece
